One of the young single men-Desire Micha was taught to drive and was chauffeur for Miss Spedding for a time. in February he and M Mallet (ex-soldier) found work at Moss Bay Steelworks and moved there, then Micha joined the Belgian Army. M Fastré found work as a gardener, and M de Greet as a farm labourer. In September 1915 the Fastré family moved to Newcastle to work in a munitions factory, and Mrs Pearson's family also moved away. All were Roman Catholic and were attended to by the Belgian priest at Cockermouth, Fr Dupont. All the children attended the village school. There are also 3 discharged Belgian soldiers (through ill-health) being looked after by Mr & Miss Rathbone.
